

Adams Pool

The pool is located at 71 Union Street in Peterborough. It is across the street from the baseball/softball fields and behind the playground. The pool season runs from the afternoon of the last day of school for the ConVal District through the middle of August. The pool complex offers the pool as well as a zero-depth splash pad, providing everyone the opportunity to cool off during the hot summer months.

\$2 person, for a resident

\$12 person, for an individual resident

* This pass is for all family members residing at that same household address.

Swimming Lessons

The PRD will be offering 8 week-long sessions of in-house swimming lessons. Classes will take place Monday through Friday, without the bad weather make-up day that was scheduled in years' past. The cost, however, continues to be the 4 day rate.

The 8 weekly sessions will begin on June 27th. We will offer Tiny Tots, Pre-Swimmers, Learning Basics, Building Skills, and Advanced Swimmers. Classes will take place between 4:30 - 6:15pm. While not all levels will be offered each session, all classes will be 1/2 hour long.

Cost: \$24/session/resident of Peterborough

Private Swimming Lessons

Private swimming lessons have gained in popularity but are dependent upon the availability of our staff. Please call us at 603-924-8080 to express your interest in participating. We will then try to work out a mutually convenient time for the participant and instructor to meet.

Cunningham Pond

When the Marshall-Thomas Recreation Area was donated to the Town, the residents voted to allow access only to Peterborough residents and their guests. In 2018, the Town voted to allow non-residents of Peterborough to buy a limited number of summer parking passes. This facility is located at 115 Cunningham Pond Road.

Parking permits are mandatory at the Pond and will be enforced by the Peterborough Police Department per Town Ordinance 195-19.1. Violation of this ordinance will result in a \$25.00 fine. For Summer 2022, we will be using burgundy 2022 stickers. All previous years' stickers are now invalid. The first sticker per Peterborough household is free; each subsequent sticker issued to that household is \$15.

Peterborough residents may pick up a free guest pass for a specified date at the PRD office during regular business hours: weekdays 8:30—4:30. Please call ahead at 603-924-8080. Guest passes are not available at the pond.

Only 125 non-resident stickers may be issued per year and are sold for \$150/sticker/vehicle. They may be picked up at the PRD office, 64 Union St., while supplies last.

Proof of residency and your car's registration is required to obtain a sticker. Each sticker is specific to one vehicle, as we write your license plate number directly on the sticker. Please place the sticker on the inside, lower right corner of your car's front windshield (passenger side).

Park Hours

The gates to the Marshall-Thomas Recreation Area are open daily to stickered vehicles from the Friday of Memorial Day weekend through the Monday of Labor Day weekend.

Staff hours will be defined as the Memorial Day weekend approaches. Restrooms will be unlocked when staff members are working at the pond.

Pond Rules

- * Parents must remain close to small children while they are in the water.
- * The pond is a **"swim at your own risk"** facility.
- * Children 15 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
- * Please heed the requests of the PRD staff.
- * The Marshall-Thomas Recreational Area is a "carry-in/carry-out" park. You must take your trash with you.
- * No open fires, no grills on the beach.
- * Patrons enjoy the quiet serenity of the pond. Please be considerate of others when using cell phones and radios.
- * Dogs may swim only in the boat ramp area. You must have control of your pets at all times. Dogs must be on a leash when not swimming and are not allowed on the sandy beach. Pets may sit in the grassy part of the swimmers' areas. Please pick up and remove your pet's waste.
- * No fishing near the swimming area.
- * No hunting or trapping.
- * No motorized off-road vehicles.
- * Boats may be launched from the ramp only.
- * Only type III, Coast Guard approved flotation devices are allowed.
- * No motorized boats.



Kayak and Paddleboard Rentals

The PRD offers single and tandem kayak rentals as well as stand up paddleboards. Children under 12 must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older. PFDs (personal flotation devices) are mandatory. We have them on hand if you need to borrow one. The last boat rental each day is an hour before the staff leaves.

When: Boats may be rented only when gate attendants are on duty. Beginning Memorial Day weekend, attendants are there weekends only, from 10am to 7pm. When the ConVal Schools close for summer recess, the pond will be staffed every day through the middle of August. Staffing returns to weekends-only from mid-August through Labor Day weekend.

Time: Staffing varies throughout the season, as above

Cost: \$5/boat/hour
\$26/boat pass consisting of 6 rentals



General Parental Advisory for Adams Pool and Cunningham Pond

- * Parents are responsible for watching their children closely.
- * If your child cannot swim, he/she should be no more than an arm's length away from you or the person responsible for supervising your child.
- * A swimming test will be given to all children at the pool. If your child does not pass, he/she is required to wear a Coast Guard approved, type III, PFD (Personal Flotation Device). We provide those at the pool. You are welcome to bring your own, but it must be inspected by a lifeguard before entering the water.
- * At the splash pad, there will be no hanging on the spray elements.
- * Walking is necessary (no running).
- * Please abide by the lifeguards' rules for the splash pad (and slide, if open).
- * No extended breath-holding play or competition allowed. This type of swimming play has been proven to lead to situations that may be life-threatening.
- * No extraneous pool flotation devices are allowed beyond the type III Coast Guard approved flotation life jackets. Examples of prohibited items include, but are not limited to, floaties, donuts, noodles, aqua-wings, etc.
- * Be aware of unseen underwater hazards (like the rocks to the left of the swimming area at Cunningham Pond).
- * Running into the water and doing shallow water dives are prohibited. These activities have been proven to lead to increased incidences of injury.
