



Peterborough Recreation Department Pickleball Program Punch Card Rules & Expectations Updated: March 23, 2026

- Punch cards are only valid for outdoor play which takes place from April 1 – September 30.
- Punch cards can only be issued by the Recreation Director, Program Coordinator, or Administrative Assistant.
- Players are still expected to sign up via Playtime Scheduler ahead of the session they intend to play.
- Punch cards can be used for guests.
- Punch cards can be purchased online or in the office. If a punch card is purchased online, the player must then come into the office to pick up their punch card during business hours.
- There are 5 visits (or punches) on each card. \$25/resident, \$50/non-resident
- Keyholders are responsible for punching once per session that a player attends. Punching tools will be in the orange box and should only be handled by keyholders.
- Punch cards expire on September 30th at the end of each outdoor season.
- Players will not be allowed to play if they come to a session without their punch card. We recommend that players keep their card in their paddle case, wallet, or vehicle so it is always with them.
- Lost punch cards are non-refundable and irreplaceable.
- Punch cards are transferable and shareable. If a player wants to give their punch card to someone else because they will no longer be using it, the gifting player should indicate on the back of the card that the card is gifted and include a signature or initials.
